THIS OFFERING IS A CALL TO SACRIFICIAL GIVING: NOW TO JULY 5

1) IMPACT

God has called us to move *and* multiply. Our church exists as a beacon of hope—a lighthouse for the lost. With this in mind we are planning an intentional outreach campaign this fall, centered around an impactful Sunday series. Consider this a 'relaunch'. Fueled by prayer, we plan to get the word out through a combination of local signs as well as targeted digital content. Additionally, we desire to bless Swift staff with some gifts of appreciation. Let's populate heaven by sharing the grace we have received.

2) WORSHIP

Due to acoustic and setup needs we will switch to an electric drum set. We also need a new interface for our sound board, as well as a laptop for visual tech portability. Well tuned sound and well presented images create a positive experience, make communication clear, and increase joy in worship.

3) LOGISTICS

From the U-Haul truck, to dollies, to pads, to totes, to gas, we have moving expenses outside of our regular budget. We will also purchase cages to store and secure our equipment at the school.

4) HOSPITALITY

Environments communicate all kinds of messages in all kinds of ways. We want our setup to visibly shout that everyone is welcome. Help us transform the space into a place of worship.

Why a Sacrificial Offering?

As part of God's plan to grow the faith of His people, He calls us to sacrificial giving. This Sacrificial Offering is an opportunity for us to grow in our faith and to prepare us for what God wants to do in this new season.

FAQS

How much should I give?

Please prayerfully consider a sacrificial gift that will stretch your faith. The precise amount you give is between you and God. Some people can give much larger gifts of many thousands. As examples, others will be able to give \$100, \$500, \$1,000, \$2,000, or more. The issue is not equal giving, but equal sacrifice. What amount can you give that will stretch your faith? If using the giving envelope, please write "Relocation". Without writing this, your gift will be designated to the general fund.

Can I give online?

Yes. When you give online through tri.church/give, simply select "Relocation Offering". We make credit card giving available because of its convenience, but we also caution people for two reasons. If you are not paying off your card please do not give with it. Also, we pay a processing fee of up to 3% on credit card giving. Over time this really builds up. In prior years Trinity has paid over \$2,000 in processing fees. We want to make giving easy for people to start, but for those who start to give regularly, we encourage them to give via bank automation or ACH bank transfer. Go to tri.church/give for instructions.

Are my gifts tax-deductible?

All gifts are tax-deductible. Your gift will be deductible in the tax year given (i.e., gifts given in 2026 will be deductible on your 2026 taxes). Please be sure to include your name and address so that we can issue your year-end statement. You are not required to utilize a tax-deduction, but it is an option for all gifts.
